# 2018 Market CSA Shares

Chickadee Creek Farm invites you to become a member of its Market CSA (Community Supported Agriculture) program. In our Market CSA, you start a debit account with the farm and in return for this commitment you receive a discount. To join, read below, then fill out and send in the form on the reverse side.

#### The way it works:

- There are four account sizes to choose from:
  - \$250 (8% DISCOUNT -Your season will start with \$270 in your Chickadee Creek Account)
  - \$300 (10% DISCOUNT -Your season will start with \$330 in your Chickadee Creek Account)\* most popular
  - \$350 (12% DISCOUNT -Your season will start with \$392 in your Chickadee Creek Account)
  - \$400 (14% DISCOUNT -Your season will start with \$456 in your Chickadee Creek Account)
- Each week you choose the quantities and types of vegetables and flowers from what is available at the farmers' market stand. You also choose when to use your account; you could spend it all at once, or spread it out through the season.
- Your vegetables, flowers and herbs are available to you at the Chickadee Creek Farm market stands on **Thursday:** at the <u>Princeton Farmers Market</u> from 10am-3pm May-Nov; on **Friday:** at the <u>Rutgers Gardens Farmers Market</u> from 12pm-5pm May-Nov, on **Saturdays:** at the <u>Metuchen Farmers Market</u> 9am-2pm mid-Jun-Nov, at the <u>Hoboken Garden Street Market</u> 9am-2 pm May-Dec, and the <u>Pennington Farmers Market</u> 9am-1pm late-may-Dec, **Sundays:** <u>Summit Farmers Market</u> on 8am-1pm April-Nov, and the <u>Denville Farmers Market</u> 8:30am-1pm year round(every other week in the winter).

- Choose only the vegetables or flowers that you and your family will use. This means easy planning to prepare food for picky-eaters and no food waste from vegetables unpopular with your family.
