2018-2019 Winter CSA Shares

Chickadee Creek Farm invites you to become a member of its 2018-2019 winter season Community Supported Agriculture program. In this CSA, you start a debit account with the farm and in return for this commitment you receive a discount. To join, read below, then fill out and send in the form on the reverse side.

The way it works:

- There are two account sizes to choose from:
 - \$100 (5% DISCOUNT** -Your season will start with \$105 in your Chickadee Creek Farm Account)
 - \$100 share is most appropriate for someone who plans to order produce 75% of the dates and will spend roughly \$15 each pick up. An example of a \$15 order is one head of lettuce, one bag of spinach, 4 large potatoes, 3 apples, and one bunch of radishes.
 - \$200 (7% DISCOUNT** -Your season will start with \$214 in your Chickadee Creek Farm Account)
 - \$200 share is most appropriate for someone who plans to order produce 75% of the dates and will spend roughly \$30 each pick up. An example of a \$30 order is two heads of lettuce, one bag of spinach, one bag of arugula, 8 large potatoes, 6 apples, one bunch of radishes, one watermelon radish, and one bunch of sweet salad turnips.
- Every other week, you will receive an e-mail from Chickadee Creek Farm with a link and online ordering form. Using the online form, you choose the quantities and types of vegetables from what is in season and available. You also choose when to use your account; you could spend it all at once or through the winter.
- Your vegetables will be dropped off between 10-11:30am on Sundays at the market parking lot on the corner of DeForest Ave and Maple Street in Summit. An e-mail reminder will be sent that morning.
- Drop off dates 2018-2019:
 - December 9th & 23rd
 - January 6th & 20th
 - February 3rd & 17th
 - March 3rd, 17th, and 31st

Benefits:

- Choose only the vegetables that you and your family will use. This means easy planning to prepare food for picky-eaters and no food waste from vegetables unpopular with your family.
- No commitment to picking up produce each week – shop in accordance with your schedule.
- Local and fresh vegetables through the winter!
